

ST KIZITO SECONDARY SCHOOL

Preamble

St Kizito Secondary School is a private English Medium Secondary School commencing with Form 1 and completing the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) program at the end of four years. Additionally willing students may opt for two-year 'Advanced Level', that is, Higher International General Certificate of Secondary Education (HIGCSE) program, which is the basic entry requirements for most commonwealth and foreign universities.

The School is owned by the Roman Catholic Church (Vicariate of Francistown). It is named after St Kizito, a young Ugandan Roman Catholic martyr, who was killed at the age of sixteen. The name, 'Kizito', is pronounced Ki- (as in 'kika') - zi- (as in 'Zibani') - to (as in 'Tonota'). St Kizito Secondary School will provide high quality academic, moral and social development for the youth, which will lay a solid foundation for higher level of education in all sectors of the economy. It is a viable option for parents seeking quality Christian education for their children. It must be noted that this is an private secondary school owned by the Roman Catholic Church and will be guided and managed under Roman Catholic Church principles. It is a co-education school with separate boarding facilities. Facilities for day students are also provided.

The first intake of students will take place in January 2012.

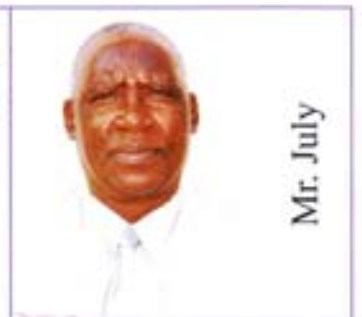

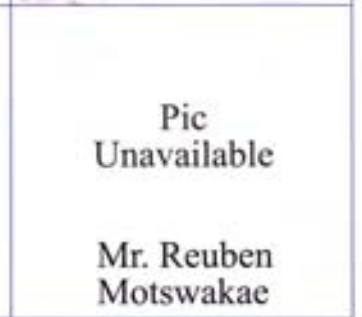

Curriculum

The School will adopt Cambridge IGCSE and HIGCSE curricula with examinations at the fourth and sixth year respectively.

There will be no Junior Certificate Examinations.

All students will take the following subjects in **Form One** and selected options at higher levels:

Science will be separated into Biology, Chemistry and Physics at higher levels.
Christian Religious Education shall be a core / compulsory subject at all levels.

Admission

Admission will be based on highly competitive academic standards. There will be no automatic promotion and minimum standards will be met in order to progress to the next level.

There will be a Development levy of P3000 payable by two installments within the first two years. Fees are not refundable when a student is expelled from school. Where a student leaves the school on his own accord then a term's notice should be given; failure of which a full term's fee is payable.

Registration Fee

There will be a registration fee of P100 payable at the collection of registration forms.

Books and Stationery

Text books will be supplied to students on loan basis and will remain the property of the School. Students will return such books to the school before they progress to the next higher stage. Lost or damaged books will be charged to the student's account. Students will provide their own stationery.

Staffing

Teaching qualifications shall be, at least, a junior degree with concurrent or teaching certificate or equivalent. Teaching experience will be an added advantage.

Non-teaching staff will be recruited as and when positions exist.

Rules and Regulations

All students will abide by rules and regulations of the school.

Uniform

Student's uniform will be bought by the parents as prescribed by the School.

Boarding

Boarding students should bring their own bedding and toiletries.

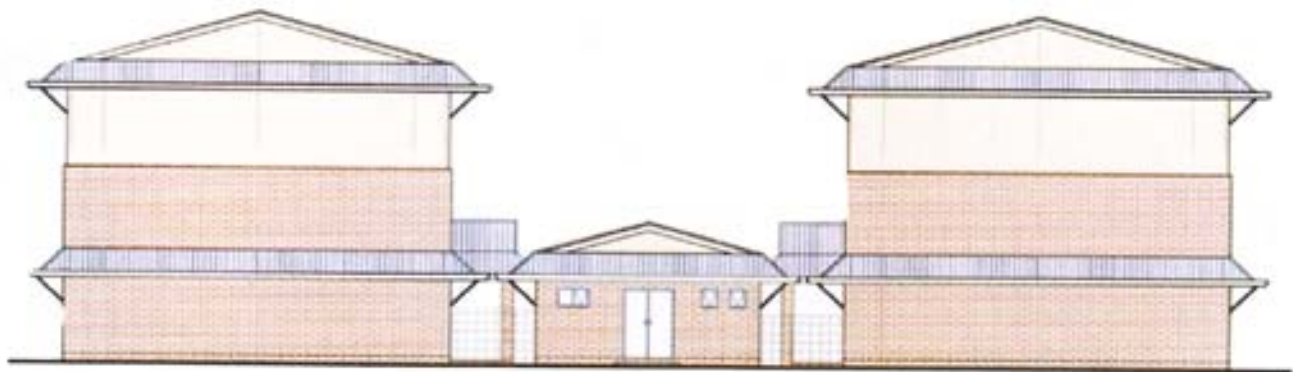
