“St. Kizito Secondary School gets registration”

Rt. Rev. Frank Nubuasah, Bishop of the Roman Catholic Vicariate of Francistown, is pleased to announce that St. Kizito Secondary School has received their registration from the Ministry of Education this week. The school is named after a 16 year old Roman Catholic martyr from Africa.

“The new Secondary School, located in the Gerald Estates area of Francistown, was built in response to a need identified by the Vicariate for a true Catholic education in Botswana” said Bishop Frank.

St. Kizito is a private English Medium Secondary School planning to start with Form 1 students in 2012 and completing the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) program at the end of five years. Additionally willing students may opt for the two year Advanced Level Higher International General Certificate of Secondary Education (HIGSCE) program, a basic entry requirement for most Commonwealth and foreign universities. It is a co-educational school with separate boarding facilities.

Bishop Frank went on to further explain that “St. Kizito Secondary School will provide high quality academic, moral and social development for the youth and is a viable option for parents seeking a quality Christian education for their children”.
